PRIVACY POLICY

1. Introduction

Fudoshin Freestyle Kickboxing Academy (“we”, “us”, “our”) is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This Privacy Policy explains how we collect, use, store and protect personal data relating to our members, parents/guardians, staff and visitors.

We process personal data in accordance with the UK General Data Protection Regulation (UK GDPR) and the Data Protection Act 2018.

2. Who This Policy Applies To

This policy applies to:

- Adult members
- Junior members and their parents/guardians
- Coaches, assistants and volunteers
- Visitors and prospective members

3. Personal Data We Collect

We may collect and process the following types of personal data:

a) Personal Information

Name

Date of birth

Email address

Telephone number

b) Junior Members

For children under 18, personal data is collected from a parent or legal guardian and may include:

Child’s name and date of birth

Emergency contact details

Relevant medical information

c) Medical Information (Special Category Data)

Injuries, medical conditions or disabilities relevant to safe participation

First aid or incident records

This information is collected only where necessary and with explicit consent.

d) Images and Media

Photographs or videos taken during training, events or gradings (only with consent)

e) Administrative Information

Membership records

Attendance records

Payments and subscription status

4. How We Use Personal Data

We use personal data for the following purposes:

- Managing memberships and participation in classes
- Ensuring the health and safety of members
- Communicating information about classes, events and changes
- Responding to emergencies
- Maintaining safeguarding and insurance requirements
- Complying with legal or regulatory obligations

5. Lawful Basis for Processing

We process personal data under the following lawful bases:

- Consent (e.g. medical information, photos/videos, junior members)
- Contract (membership and training services)
- Legal obligation (safeguarding, insurance, health and safety)
- Legitimate interests (club administration and communication)

6. Sharing Personal Data

- We do not sell or share personal data for marketing purposes.
- Personal data may be shared only where necessary, including with:
 - Coaches and instructors (for safety and training purposes)
 - First aiders or medical professionals in an emergency
 - Governing bodies or insurers where required
 - Legal or regulatory authorities if required by law

All data sharing is limited to what is necessary and appropriate.

7. Data Storage and Security

We take appropriate technical and organisational measures to protect personal data, including:

Secure storage of physical records

Password-protected digital systems

Limited access to personal data on a need-to-know basis

Personal data is retained only for as long as necessary for the purposes for which it was collected.

8. Children's Data

We take special care when handling children's personal data. Data relating to junior members is processed only with parental or guardian consent and is used solely for participation, safety and administrative purposes.

9. Your Rights - Under UK GDPR, you have the right to:

Access your personal data

Request correction of inaccurate data

Request erasure of data (where applicable)

Restrict or object to processing

Withdraw consent at any time

Requests can be made in writing using the contact details below.

10. Photography and Video

Photographs or videos will only be taken and used in accordance with the consent provided.

Consent may be withdrawn at any time.

11. Changes to This Policy

We may update this Privacy Policy from time to time. The most current version will be made available upon request or displayed at the club.
